Registration is available at both units and will be ongoing as of February 15th 2010. Registration continues until weekly sessions are filled. Space is limited so we encourage you to register early. Registration is accepted in person only. Payment will be accepted in the form of cheque, cash, Visa, or Mastercard.

We do not accept debit cards.

Non-refundable deposit of \$30.00 per session per child required at time of registration. Payment can be made in full at time of registration or the balance can be paid by post dated cheques dated one week prior to start of the session.

\$10.00 charge applied per child per session for any registration changes. All registration changes must be made in person. Refunds not issued with less than 14 days notice.
